Director Dollenmayer read the No Change Agenda. The co-chair called for questions or comments on the No Change Agenda. There were no questions or comments from the Committee or the public.




The co-chair called for other questions or comments on the Regular Agenda. Representative Skindell made a motion to invalidate rules 3701-59-06 and 3701-83-60, stating the rules were beyond statutory authority, violated federal law,

did not accurately detail adverse impact on business, and were against legislative intent. Senator DeMora seconded the motion. Representative Peterson motioned to lay the motion to invalidate on the table. Representative Skindell called for point of order to remove the motion to lay the motion to invalidate on the table. A vote was taken on whether to invalidate the rules. By a vote of 6-4, the motion to invalidate failed. There were no further questions or comments from the Committee or the public.

The co-chair reminded the Committee and the public that the next JCARR meeting would be held on May 13, 2024 at 1:30 p.m. in the Senate Finance Hearing Room. Co-chair Gavarone adjourned the meeting at 2:55p.m.
